The Joint Groundfish/Scallop Committee of the New England Fishery Management Council will meet to begin the preparation of a management action to facilitate the transfer of yellowtail flounder allocations between the groundfish and scallop industries.

The Committee will:

- Develop a problem statement for the action
- Identify measureable goals and objectives
- Identify management alternatives. One alternative the Committee will develop would allow the formation of sectors within the scallop fishery for the sole purpose of exchanging yellowtail flounder with groundfish sectors established under the provisions of the Northeast Multispecies Fishery Management Plan. Other alternatives may also be developed by the Committee.
- Other business may be discussed.

The Committee's recommendations will be delivered to the full Council at its meeting in Mystic, CT on April 27-29, 2010.

**Directions:**

***FROM Points South via I-93:***

Heading northbound on I-93 towards Boston, take Exit 20, which will be immediately after Exit 18. Follow the signs to "I-90 East." Take the first tunnel exit to "South Boston." At the first set of lights at the top of the ramp, proceed straight onto East Service Road. At the next set of lights, take a right onto Seaport Boulevard. The Seaport Boulevard entrance to the Seaport Garage will be ahead on the right.

***FROM Points North via I-93:***

Heading southbound on Interstate 93 Boston, take Exit 23, Purchase Street and move into the left lane. At the top of the ramp, take a left turn onto the Evelyn Moakley Bridge/Seaport Boulevard. Follow Seaport Boulevard for approximately .8 miles, the Seaport Boulevard entrance to the Seaport Garage will be on the right, after the Seaport Boulevard/B Street intersection.

***From Logan International Airport:*** Exit airport and follow signs for the Ted Williams Tunnel. Take exit 24 for 93 North. Follow 93 North to Exit 23, Government Center. Take the first left onto North Street. The hotel is the first building on the right. ***Travel via Taxi or Airport Water Shuttle from Logan:*** Approximately \$20/one way via taxi or \$17/roundtrip via water shuttle. Book water shuttle at: <http://www.citywatertaxi.com/> \$17. The stop for pickup and drop off is at the Seaport World Trade Center, directly across the street from the hotel.
