01 FEB 2009: Satellites no longer monitor 121.5 MHz

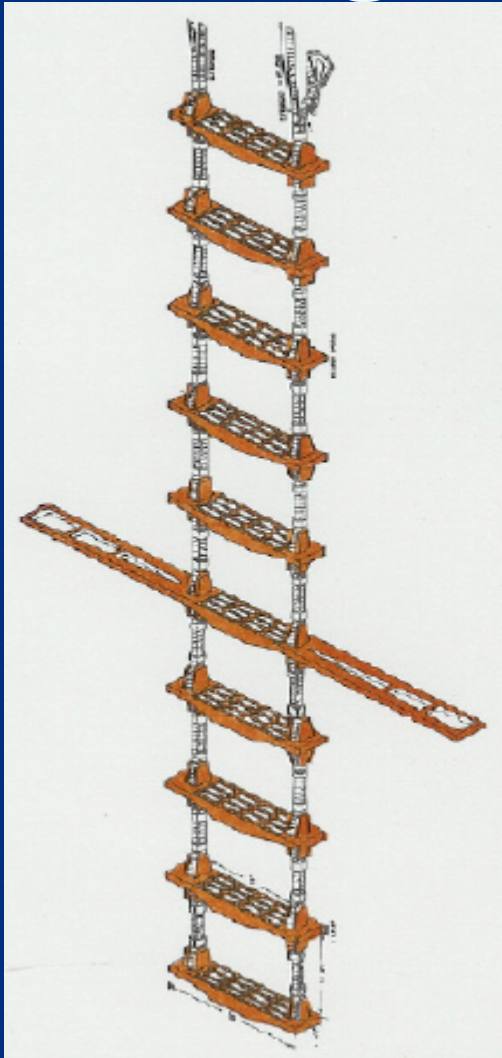
406 MHz EPIRB unaffected

Boarding Ladder Final Rule

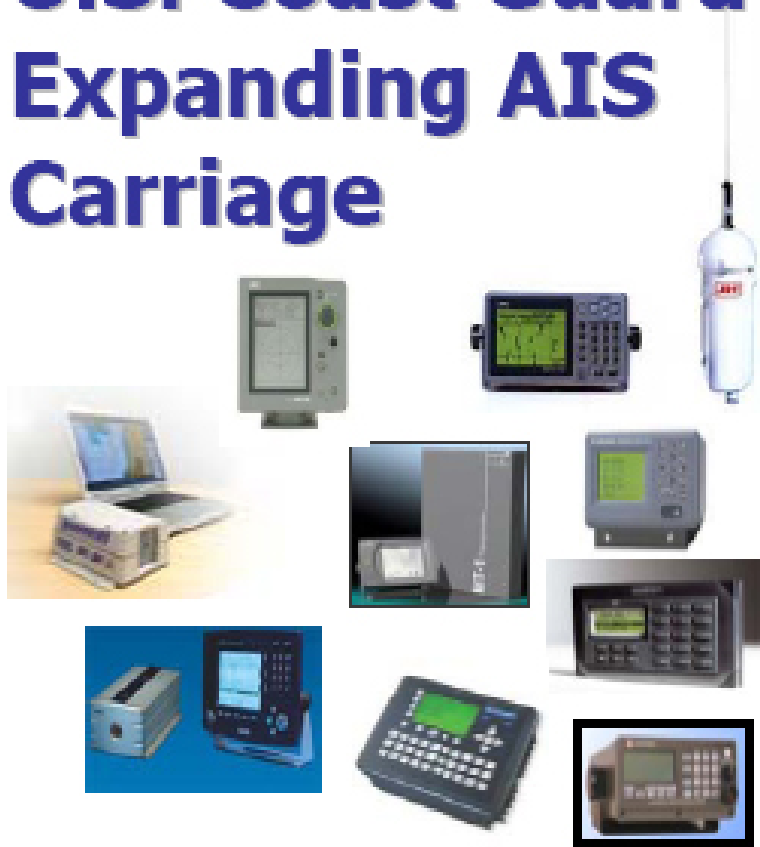


- Effective 01 JAN 09
- “Safe boarding ladder” defined as a Coast Guard approved pilot ladder.
- “Freeboard” defined as the working distance between the top rail of the gunwale, where the boarding officer climbs into the vessel, and the water’s surface
- This rule establishes a safer and more enforceable national standard for ladders used by authorized officers for boarding domestic fishing vessels.
